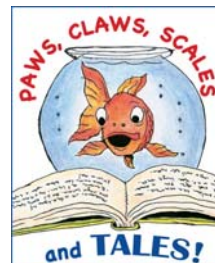
for anything of value to the school. We are going to focus our efforts on collecting Box Tops for Education.
